The Club Memorandum and Articles of Association, article 36. and the Club Bye-Law 12. Absent Membership Short Term.

36. Absent Membership Short Term

- a) For periods of absence up to 3 months, all classes of Membership shall be required to continue paying monthly subscriptions.
- b) The minimum food and beverage charge and car parking charges may be waived after one full calendar month on condition that:
 - i. the Member informs the Secretary in writing in advance of the period of absence;
 - ii. his spouse and dependants do not use the Club during this period
- c) For continuous absences from Hong Kong between 3 and 12-months duration all subscriptions may be waived providing the above conditions are observed and the Member informs the Secretary promptly upon his return that he will recommence using the Club. Full Membership rights may be resumed only after receipt of such written notice by the Club Secretary and upon payment of any fees due during the period of absence.

Bye-Laws of the Club

12. Absent Membership Short Term

- a) Member being continuously absent and staying overseas (not including PRC) for a period of more than 3 months, and not more than 12 months, may apply for Absent Membership Short Term. If approved, his monthly subscription during the period of absence will be waived. His application for Absent Membership Short Term each time is subject to an Administration Fee imposed to be decided by the General Committee.

In resuming his membership after a short-term absence, his Ordinary Membership with the Club is seen to be fresh, and when he intends to re-apply for Absent Membership Short Term next time, his application will only be accepted and considered after one year has lapsed from the date of his last resumption of Ordinary Membership.
